Bird and/or Mammal Intake Coordinator

Work under the direction of the licensed wildlife rehabilitators and coordinate all aspects of the admission process for both birds and mammals, including triage, euthanasia, medicating, anesthesia, and feeding. Greenwood is a large, non-profit, wildlife rehabilitation center in Longmont, CO that treats approximately 3000 injured and orphaned animals a year. Animals are cared for and released back to the wild. Though this job entails helping individual animals, we have a broader mission of public education. We answer over 5000 questions a year that relate to the growing human/wildlife interface along the Front Range and provide solutions for wildlife/human conflict. Greenwood cares for injured and orphaned passerines, waterfowl, columbids, raccoons, coyotes, fox, squirrels, rabbits and many other native Colorado species.

CVT degree important but not required if excellent technical skills with wildlife, including both birds and mammals. Avian/exotic experience will be considered also.

Wildlife biology or Zoology education helpful.
