Work under the direction of the licensed wildlife rehabilitators and help oversee all aspects of the wildlife mammal nursery, including feeding, cleaning, and supervising volunteers. Biology, Zoology or Vet Tech education helpful. Experience with carnivores or rodents a plus but not necessary though some form of animal handling experience required. Greenwood is a large wildlife rehabilitation center in Longmont, CO that treats approximately 3000 injured and orphaned animals a year. Animals are cared for and released back to the wild. Though this job entails helping individual animals, we have a broader mission of public education. We answer over 5000 questions a year that relate to the growing human/wildlife interface along the Front Range and provide solutions for wildlife/human conflict. This job can offer valuable handling experience for future wildlife rehabilitators, biologists, animal behaviorists, veterinary technicians, or veterinarians.
