WILDLIFE REHABILITATION CENTER

Greenwood's mission is to rehabilitate orphaned, injured, and sick wildlife for release into appropriate habitats. We are the largest wildlife rehabilitation center treating mammals, birds, and waterfowl on Colorado's Front Range. We care for thousands of animals annually and over 200 different species have come through our doors since we were founded in 1982.

We also provide outreach programs for people of all ages regarding rehabilitation, humane solutions to human-wildlife conflicts, and how you can help Colorado's wildlife.



THE PROGRAM

Greenwood hosts several 8 and 12-week sessions throughout the spring, summer, and fall. The internship is meant to provide animal husbandry experience with our wild patients and on-the-job training in basic rehabilitation skills. For example:



handling techniques



cleaning/sterilization procedures



Mabitat enrichment



🚜 food preparation

A minimum of 20 hours per week is required for the full length of the internship. Shifts vary, please check online. There could be 5 -10 hours spent standing, walking, bending, twisting, and lifting.

REQUIREMENTS

Qualifications Previous experience in animal care—whether wildlife or domesticated animals—is not required. We consider interns from all backgrounds. We believe that an interest in wildlife, a strong work ethic, and willingness to learn are most important.



You must be 18 years old to apply



Provide proof of tetanus vaccination



Available at least three days per week



Ability to work nights, mornings, & weekends



Must be proficient in English



Up-to-date pre-exposure rabies vaccination is required to work with rabies vector species

GET INVOLVED

Internships are unpaid. All applicants must have a valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and local housing.
