A Dark-eyed Junco's Story

A Dark-eyed Junco arrived at Greenwood when a caring person found it unable to fly in their backyard. This bird required intensive treatment after presumably striking a window. The critter sustained a severe injury with its wing bruised and swollen. Staff provided medications and wrapped its shoulder and wing. Rehabilitators have high hopes this bird will heal and fly again soon. In the meantime, this Dark-eyed Junco is enjoying cage rest and gorging on mealworms, millet, and finch seed.
